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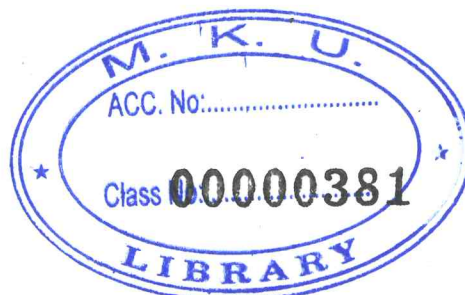
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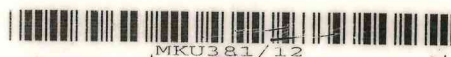

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study was to investigate the factors affecting academic performance of students in English in selected secondary schools.
