## ABSTRACT

The main purpose of this study was to investigate the effects of poor SFP on ECDE enrollment in Kawalase Zone Turkana Central District. In the study two pre-schools were sampled to represent (10%) of the 20 pre-schools in the whole zone using stratified sampling technique.

In each of the pre-schools a total of 25 respondents were selected to represent four categories of teachers, children, parents and opinion leaders.

A structure questionnaire with closed ended questions was used to carry out the interview which appears in this report as appendix i-iv. The data was analyzed quantitatively to establish trends and tendencies and it was presented in form of frequencies, tables, graphs and pie-charts.

The finding and the recommendations of the study will help improve the provision of SFP in pre-schools in order to increase enrolment, prevent drop outs and stabilize attendance at pre-school in Kawalase zone Turkana district.
