Stratified sampling technique will be used to group the schools as provincial and district.

According to Coopers et al (2001) systematic stratified sampling is where the population is first divided into strata; study sample sizes are then drawn from every stratum. The researcher will ensure that all the categories of schools in the area of study are represented in the sample size.
