## **ABSTRACT.**

The purpose of the study was to investigate the success of the child friendly schools (CFS) initiative in Kianjai Education Zone, Tigania West District. The researcher sampled 20 public primary schools out of the 27 schools in the zone. The head teachers of the schools were all interviewed while 20 assistant teachers were sampled and data collected from them by use of questionnaires. Data collected was analyzed and presented in simple tables and figures. The researcher was guided in the assessment by the four aspects of a friendly school as stipulated by the Ministry of Education in the CFS manual for schools. The findings have shown that the CFS initiative has not been well implemented.

The researcher also came up with recommendations that should be undertaken to enhance the implementation and success of the CFS initiative. All stakeholders i.e. teachers, parents, the government and the non government organizations should fully take up the project with enthusiasm and the seriousness that it deserves.
