## ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study is to assess the impact of feeding programme on enrollment and performance of primary school children kibera zone langata district in Nairobi county .this study was guided by the following objectives: To determine primary schools children offering feeding programme in Kibera zone to evaluate impact of feeding programme on school attendance of primary school children in kibera zone. The design adopted for this study was descriptive design. The researcher targeted 100 children, 50 parents and 60 teachers in five primary schools. Stratified and simple random sampling comprising of 45 children, 15 teachers and 30 parents. Questionnaires for teacher's achievement tests and interview schedules was used to collect data. The researcher arranged research instruments and analyzed using simple statistical measures like mean and percentages. The analyzed data was presented in form of table, graphs and pie charts. Finding showed that majority of school after feeding in Kibera Zone. Among the schools which after feeding programme include Mashimoni Squatters, Glory and Magoso feeding programme increased enrolment, stabilized attendance and improved academic performance. It was conducted that feeding among children increased concentration children actively participated in classwork hence improved performance as noted in Mashimoni squatters, glory and Magoso.
