ABSTRACT

This study intends to explore the effectiveness of community policing and community policing programme in Ongata Rongai Division.

The purpose of the study is to determine the organizational structure, attitudinal and institutional capacity research questions when then drawn from the objectives whose answers were written after undetaking the study.

The literature review outlines the sources of literature that have so far been fathered in relation to this concept. Some of the factors to the success are discussed.
