## ABSTRACT

The study was carried out in Tetu Division of Nyeri County. General failure had been noted in most of the secondary schools over a number of years. It made it necessary to carry out research on determinants of performance in Geography a subject applicable in all works of evaluating performance of either individuals, group, organizations or the government.

Data was collected from a sample of 164 students to representing 1440 students in the 9 secondary schools of Tetu Division whereby only 540 students took Geography. Questionnaires were provided to geography teachers and students of the various schools that were sampled. The results were analyzed using tables, bar graphs (charts) and percentages.
