ABSTRACT

The study aimed at investigating the major causes of indiscipline in secondary schools in reference to Kegogo division in Marani district, Kisii County. The objectives of this study are to investigate the prevalence of students indiscipline in high schools, to find out the major cause of indiscipline among high school students and to find viable solutions to the problems of indiscipline among high school students. The data was collected from ninety six (96) respondents by use of questionnaires in six schools. The data was analyzed by use of frequency distribution and percentages. Some of the major causes sighted by the respondents of various schools are- poor school administration, incompetent headteachers, lack of teamwork between the headteachers, teachers and the parents, poor examination result drug abuse in boys schools, laxity among the members of staff, unclear policies by free school administration, poor diet, lack of teaching facilities, permissiveness in the society e.t.c. The researcher recommended that the teachers should use amicable and understanding- ways, in solving discipline problems. These ways range from having proper strict laid down rules and regulations, use of appraisal, being examples and lastly discipline through understanding and consideration.
