## **ABSTRACT**

The main objective of this study is to examine and find out the major factors that influence the choosing of KCSE subjects by form two students. Mainly, the procedures which are normally used to choose subjects during a student's second form in his/her high school curriculum have been found wanting. Clear and well guided information to the students concerning career choice and respective subjects governing their interests is the ultimate measure that ought to be taken to ensure that students' future is well catered for.

This study is meant to highlight the factors that have been in one way or another influencing which subjects one should take in preparation to the final Kenya Certificate of Secondary Examination.

This study is going to be carried out to form two students in Tigania East Division, Tigania East District in Meru County.
