ABSTRACT

This report explores the impact of quality teaching staff in primary schools on academic performance of pupils in kangari division, kigumo district. It focuses on the quality of the teacher in terms of training and classroom habits that affect the pupils' level of grasping the taught concepts. The schools visited include; Muiria, Mairi, Mwarano, Gacharage and Ikumbi Primary Schools all in Kangari Division. The school administrators, teachers and pupils were interviewed either orally or by way of questionnaire. This report points out how the quality of the teacher affects the pupil's performance. It therefore recommends that the government teacher training colleges and other stake holders must re-evaluate the teachers' competence, in view of improving quality teaching.
