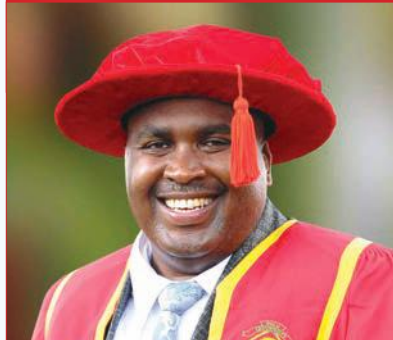

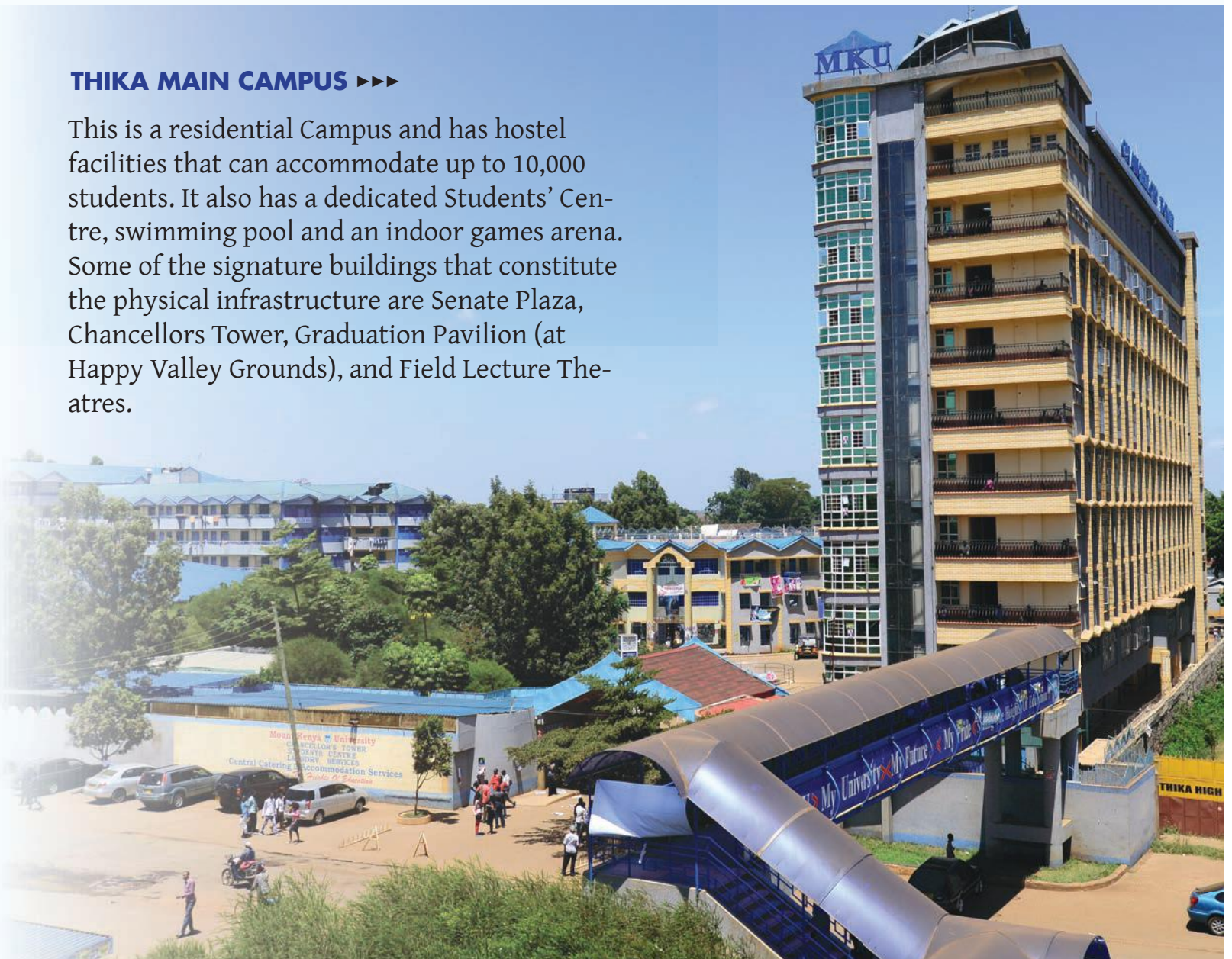

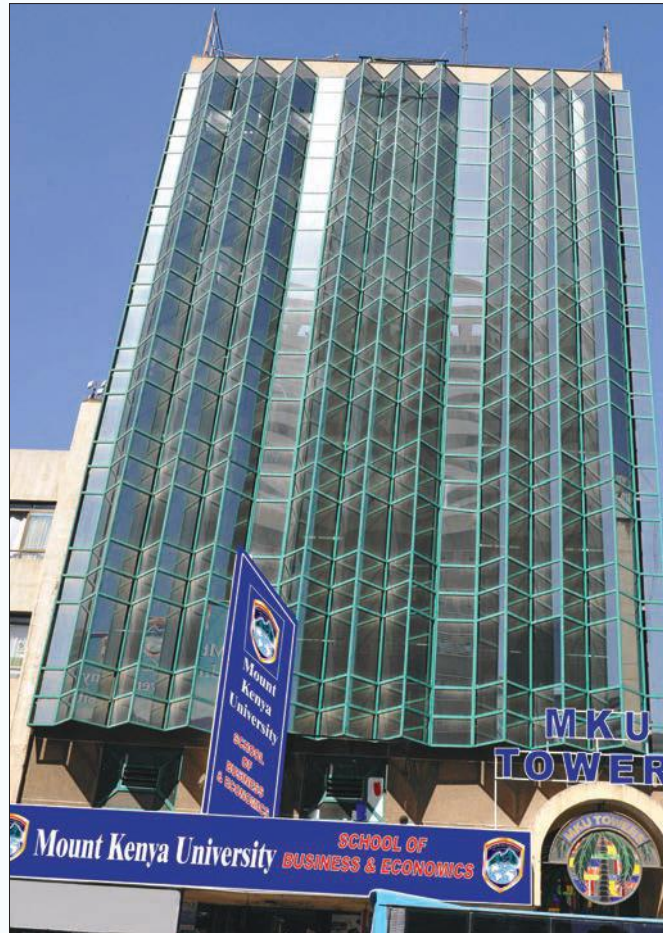
MKU Parklands School of Law

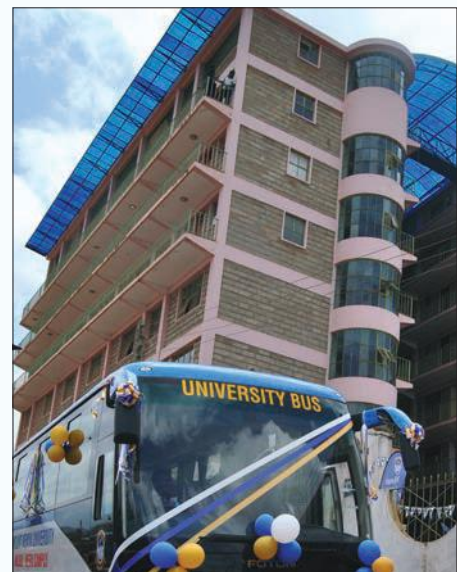
Mega Mall, Kakamega town, plays host to Kakamega Campus. The Campus also operates from another location in the outskirts of Kakamega town.
