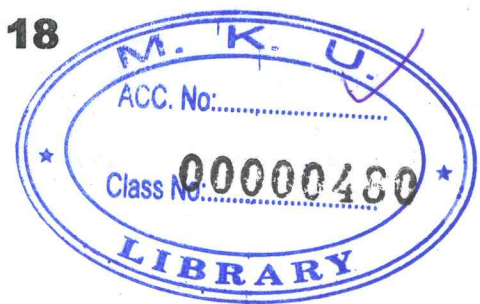

ABSTRACT
