

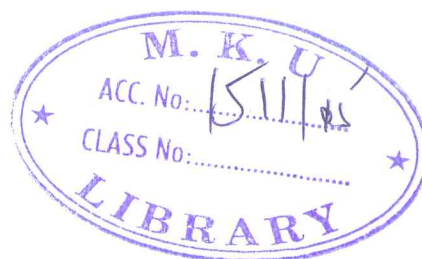
**IMPACT OF INDISCIPLINE ON ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE

ABSTRACT

Indiscipline in secondary schools is very common. It is caused by parenting style, teachers' favoritism, unclear rules and regulations, indiscipline teachers, drug substances abuse, communication, mode of dressing and lack of proper facilities in schools. This study aims at investigating the effects of indiscipline performance in public schools in Nairobi and role of stakeholder and possible solution to indiscipline.

An explanatory case study research design was used in this study. Out of 2,429 students, 4 head teachers and 126 teachers, the targeted population was 91 students, 2 head teachers and 8 teachers. Using random systematic random sampling techniques a sample size of 103 was selected for the study.

Questionnaires and group discussions were used for data collection. Statistics such as mean, frequencies and percentage were used to explain the meaning of collected data using structured questions. The knowledge obtained from the study was used to give suggestions on how negative results of indiscipline could be handled. This would help in promoting good academic performance.
