## **ABSTRACT**

The background of the study has shown that one of the factors that affect performance and attendance in primary schools in Kibwezi sub-county is HIV and AIDS. This problem is experienced both in the rural and the urban areas. The purpose of the study is to investigate the effects of HIV/AIDS on enrolment in secondary schools in Kathyaka Zone in Kibwezi sub-county.

The research approach will be quantitative and the research design is a survey one. The target population will be comprised of students from form one-form four and secondary school teachers from ten public schools in Kathyaka Zone. The sample size is thirty.
